

Code of Conduct for Older Driver Assessment

The code of conduct for the Older Driver Assessment Scheme is a standard issued by Transport for NSW to driving instructors that have been accredited by Transport for NSW to conduct assessment of applicants for driver licences.

It is issued by Transport for NSW under Clause 2.5 - Obligations of Provider, Clause 12.2 - Bribery and codes and 12.3 - Conflict of Interest of the accreditation agreement for assessment of older drivers

Under the accreditation agreement, the assessor is required to comply with the standards of behaviour set out in this code of conduct.

The code of conduct covers the following:

1. Safety
2. Diversity and inclusion
3. Responsibilities
4. Confidentiality
5. Conflict of interest
6. Acceptance of bribes
7. Acceptance of gifts and benefits
8. Fraud and corruption prevention
9. Reporting corrupt conduct
10. Compliance and enforcement
