

# Vehicle Ownership Search

Company Liquidators, Administrators, Receivers

Sections 477(3), 530B, s.438C, s.431 *Corporations Act 2001*

## Process

1. Use this form to obtain details of vehicles currently or previously owned by the company.
2. We will advise you of:
  - vehicles currently owned by the company
  - vehicles previously owned by the company within the nominated search period
  - date the company disposed of the vehicle within the nominated search period
  - price advised to us for the disposal
3. If you wish to obtain the name and address of the buyer for a disposed vehicle then you must complete [Form 5633](#) (Vehicle Buyer Search). Normally you will need to complete this Vehicle Ownership Search Form first to identify vehicle ownership before applying for the buyer search.
