## Buyer search

Use this form to obtain the name and address of the buyer of a vehicle which a bankrupt individual has disposed of.

## Ownership & disposal search

Normally, before you use this form to obtain a buyer's details, you will first need to lodge [Form 5632](#) (Bankruptcy Vehicle Ownership Search) to confirm that the bankrupt was the vehicle owner at the time of disposal.

Otherwise you may apply for the buyer's details by making an [Access Application](#) under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 (NSW)*.

Before you can complete this form normally you will first need to have lodged **Form 5632** (Vehicle Ownership Search) to search for vehicles owned by the company as you cannot request buyer information unless you have confirmed that the company owned and disposed of the vehicle
