- Use this form to obtain details of vehicles currently or previously owned by the bankrupt.
- We will advise you of:
 - vehicles currently owned by the bankrupt.
 - vehicles previously owned by the bankrupt within the nominated search period
 - date the bankrupt disposed of the vehicle within the nominated search period
 - price advised to us for the disposal
- If you wish to obtain the name and address of the buyer for a disposed vehicle then you must complete **Form 5657** (Bankruptcy Vehicle Buyer Search). Normally you will need to complete this Vehicle Ownership Search form first to confirm the bankrupt's ownership of the vehicle before applying for the buyer search.
