Warning: we can only release the name and address of the buyer if we have that information on a notice of disposal or receipt which was signed by or lodged with us by or on behalf of the bankrupt. This is because we can only release information to you from "books and records kept by the bankrupt" and unless the bankrupt signed or lodged the document, the records are not bankrupt records. Otherwise you may apply for the buyer's details by making an [Access Application](#) under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 (NSW)* OR by the Official Receiver serving a s.77C Notice compelling the release of the information.

Before you can complete this Form normally you will first need to have lodged [Form 5656](#) (Bankruptcy Vehicle Ownership Search) to search for vehicles owned by the Bankrupt as you cannot request Buyer information unless you have confirmed that the Bankrupt owned and disposed of the vehicle.
