An application can be completed online at service.nsw.gov.au or in person at a service centre within 14 days of purchasing/acquiring a vehicle or a late application fee will be charged.

Number plates must be attached to the vehicle at time of sale for transfer of registration.

Check the last page of this form for a guide to applying to transfer registration.

To register a vehicle in your name you must be at least 16 years of age for a light vehicle (up to 4.5 tonnes GVM) and at least 18 years of age for a heavy vehicle (over 4.5 tonnes GVM).

To complete an application online you must have an online services account and the notice of disposal must be lodged by the seller and recorded by Service NSW.

You have 14 days to transfer the registration after purchasing/acquiring a vehicle.

When a vehicle changes ownership, Transport for NSW needs to update its records. Complete this form and attend a Service NSW centre. Or if you are eligible to do so, you can complete this transaction online. Applications by mail will not be accepted.

You should have the current certificate of registration for the vehicle. Make sure it is signed on the back by the seller.

If you do not have the current certificate of registration, you will need to provide proof of entitlement to transfer the registration, for example, an original receipt for the vehicle which clearly shows:

- your name
- the seller's name, address and signature
- the registration plate number of the vehicle
- the VIN or chassis number
- the date that you bought the vehicle
- how much you paid for it.

If you can not provide any proof of entitlement to transfer the registration your application may be refused.

Heavy Vehicle over 4.5 tonnes GVM

If you are transferring the registration of a heavy vehicle over 4.5 tonnes GVM, you must also indicate the Nominated Configuration Code at question 11.

Proof of Identity (POI)

Your POI documents must be originals and include your signature and residential address.

When you attend a service centre, you need to show proof of identity (POI). You can use your current NSW driver photo licence or one which expired within the last two years. For a list of acceptable POI documents visit nsw.gov.au or call Service NSW on **13 22 13**.

Corporations are required to provide one of the following when being established as a Transport for NSW customer for the first time, or to change its name:

- Certificate of Registration, with Australian Company Number (ACN)
- A current Extract of the Company, with ACN
- Certificate of Registration on Change of Name with ACN
- A printed extract from the Australian Securities Investment Commission (ASIC) website with ACN
- Certificate of Incorporation issued by the NSW Fair Trading or an Association Summary from NSW Fair Trading's online search facility.
- Certificate of Registration of a Foreign Company, with Australian Registered Body Number (ARBN) for companies incorporated overseas.

Government authorities or organisations incorporated under legislation must provide on letterhead the name of the Act under which they are incorporated when being established as a Transport for NSW customer for the first time, or to change its name.

Courtesy name

This field may be used to record an organisation name. This name will be recorded on the Certificate of Registration. The name recorded in this field is not the registered operator of the vehicle.

Representative authority

If you send someone else to the service centre to apply to transfer the registration to your name, fill in the representative authority section of this form. If the vehicle is being registered in the name of a corporation, the representative authority must be filled in. For a company, the director or an authorised delegate must complete and sign the representative authority. In the case of incorporated association, the public officer must sign. In all cases, the authorised representative must provide proof of their identity.

If you are not already recorded on Transport's database, you must attend the service centre in person and provide POI.

Transfer fee, late application fee and additional fees

A transfer fee is applicable. If you do not apply to transfer the registration within 14 days of purchasing/acquiring the vehicle, a late application fee also applies. Additional motor vehicle tax may apply if you bought the vehicle from a pensioner who received a tax concession and you're not entitled to the concession.

Stamp duty

Stamp duty is collected by Transport for NSW on behalf of Revenue NSW when registration is issued to a different person or corporation. Stamp duty is based on the market value of the vehicle or the price you paid, whichever is greater. Stamp duty is calculated at \$3 per \$100, or part, of the vehicle's value.

For passenger vehicles valued over \$45,000 with seating for up to 9 occupants, including: a sedan, station wagon, coupe, convertible, four wheel drive vehicle with seats and windows, two wheel drive panel van with seats and windows, three wheel car, forward control passenger vehicle, small bus, motor home, or snow vehicle the rate of stamp duty is \$1,350 plus \$5 per \$100, or part, of the vehicle's value over \$45,000.

You can use this method to calculate the amount of stamp duty payable for your vehicle, or you can use the motor vehicle registration duty calculator at revenue.nsw.gov.au
