

Application for an Approved Organisation

Classic Vehicle Scheme

Use this form to apply as an Approved Organisation in the Classic Vehicle Scheme. The following must be attached to this application:

- Evidence of the organisation's corporate status. (eg Certificate of Registration issued by the Australian Securities and Investment Commission, or Certificate of Incorporation issued by NSW Fair Trading).
- A copy of the Approved Organisation constitution demonstrating that the organisation can meet the Classic Vehicle Scheme policy.
- A list of a minimum of 50 motoring clubs associated with the Approved Organisation.
- A list of representatives forming the organisation's proposed Eligibility Committee.
- The name and contact details of the proposed Eligibility Committee's Responsible Person.
- The criteria applied to a vehicle for it to be accepted as an eligible Classic Vehicle (if more strict than the relevant NSW vehicle standards).

- The inspection process and proof of compliance requirements used to demonstrate that an eligible Classic Vehicle meets the above criteria (if the criteria is more strict than the relevant NSW vehicle standards).
- Materials (such as policies and procedures documents, etc) that demonstrate the organisation has professional and safety standards to provide sufficient administrative controls over the following areas:
 - · vehicle construction
 - vehicle logbooks
